## PORTAGE PUBLIC LIBRARY DIRECTOR'S REPORT MARCH 2018

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

#### **Staffing**

- Director position is posted to: DLT Classified Page, UW-Madison iSchool Jobs Board, UW-Milwaukee Jobs Board, SCLS-Announce, Job Center of Wisconsin, SCLS Homepage, and our library webpage (linked from City page) with an application deadline of April 17, 2018.
- Substitute librarian Carol Iwanowski has been scheduled on the reference desk for the next few months to help out until the new director is hired.

#### **Updates**

- Results of inventory: see attached report.
- Friends of the Library met 3/14 and passed my proposed change to the disbursement process. Starting in the new fiscal year (Oct 2018) the Friends will give the library the funds to be spent that fiscal year for programming at the beginning of the year. (A change from the previous reimbursement method.) The funds are to be depositing in Contingent/Restricted account and spent from there. Library Director to give report at FOL meetings how the funds have been spent.
- A no-trespass one year ban was issued to a teen due to ongoing behavior problems and violations of the public behavior policy. He previously received warnings, and shorter bans (one day, one week, one month) before ultimately receiving the one year no tresspass. Police Department and teen's parent have been
- In-Service Day held Mar. 30. Had crisis prevention training from Jean Anderson SCLS in the morning with other county library staff, in the afternoon gave service awards and worked on projects (moving graphic novel collections, completing inventory final search for missing items).
- Completed article for City summer newsletter
- Joe is working on completing security camera install in alley and by front desk.
- Summer Lunch Program plans being finalized, Stephanie Helmann will again work for both the library and the lunch program this year.
- Current phase of teen space update is almost complete. Window is installed, wall painted, counter & outlets installed, board wall installed (white board needs to be refinished). Will start to look at next phase of project with the Foundation- painting main area, furniture purchases, Smartboard purchase.
- Sprinkler pipe replacement update: as of Monday 4/9 the new RFP has not yet been completed/posted by city engineering staff.
- Bassett Mechanical did our quarterly HVAC maintenance and found some heating water pipe leaks. Joe will
  be working with them to schedule repair of these and a valve that was identified as faulty earlier this winter.
  Waiting for warm weather for these repairs because the boilers will have to be shut down for a day.
