THE READING PROGRAM RUNS MAY 29TH - JULY 27TH !

1.) Hop on a computer and head to the following link:

wandooreader.com/portagelibrary/2018-teen-summer-reading

2.) Register a username and password. You'll need a valid e-mail address! The Reading Program is logged only ONLINE.

- ◆ If you had already registered for the last years programs, you can log-in using the same username and password. You just have to confirm a few pieces of information!

3.) Log in, and record how many minutes you spend reading during June & July. Every 300 minutes, or 5 hours, completes a "challenge" on Wando, and makes you eligible to claim a ticket at the library. 20 tickets total available to get!

4.) Write your name, phone #, and non-school e-mail address on the back of each ticket you get. Deposit them in whichever prize jars you like, and we'll do a drawing at the end of July!

A FEW MORE DETAILS... IF YOU NEED 'EM!

~ "Which kind of books count for the reading program?"

- ◆ Pretty much any book you could check out at the library! Manga, graphic novels, fiction, non-fiction, comic books... they all count! Audiobooks count too!

~ "Which kind of books DO NOT COUNT?"

- ◆ "Class focused" reading would NOT count. Textbooks, worksheets, printouts for summer school... they do not apply to the Summer Reading Program. Neither do ONLINE ARTICLES. So, in other words, studying and website browsing shouldn't be logged!

~ "So, how exactly does Wandoo reader work?"

- ◆ It might seem confusing at first, but it's pretty simple! Once you've registered for our Summer 2018 Teen Reading Program on Wandoo Reader, log in and you can record the books you'll be reading throughout June & July.
- ◆ This online-only Reading Program consists of 20 "challenges" - each challenge consists of 5 hours (or 300 minutes) of reading. Every 300 minutes you log "completes" the challenge, and lets you know you can "Redeem an award". To do this, go to the desk and let a staff member know you are ready to get a ticket. You can claim your tickets either one at a time or all at once!
- ◆ You should then write your FULL NAME, PHONE NUMBER, and E-MAIL ADDRESS (not a school one) on the back of each ticket. Deposit them in the "Prize Jars" located behind the library desk.
- ◆ At the end of the reading program, Chris will do a random ticket drawing to see who won! SO - the more you read, the more tickets you earn, the better your chances!
